*Jeremiah's night in the stocks (vv1-3) is one of reflection in which he concludes that if he is a false prophet he is completely undone (vv7-8), but these really are the words of the Lord (v9), so the Lord will protect him (vv10-12). These leads to Paul-n-Silas style praise in the prison (v13). Yet, even with such certainties, God's servants' experiences in this life while they wait can include the deepest pain and anguish (vv14-18).*
